

HALLOWEEN TRUNK-OR-TREAT

This year's Clinton School Halloween Trunk-or-Treat will be held Friday, October 31st, from 11:45 am – 2:05 pm. Parents are invited to watch the Parade on the front lawn of school, and are encouraged to come in costume!

Decorated cars will be backed up to the curb in the front part of the parking lot. As of today, there will be eight Halloween inspired cars.

Students will parade with their classes out the front door (by the Nurse's office), down the sidewalks to visit the decorated cars and get their treats, and back through the main door. In the event of rain, Trunk-or-Treat will be moved to the cafeteria.

Each grade will parade through at a specified time. We will do our best to keep to this schedule, but ask families to be flexible – times could slide a bit in either direction depending on everything from how quickly the kids walk, to the weather. So plan to come a bit early and/or stay a bit late to make sure you catch your kids. The schedule is as follows:

- 11:45 – 12:00pm – Third Grade
- 12:15 – 12:30 pm – Kindergarten
- 12:45 – 1:05 pm – First Grade
- 1:15 – 1:30 pm – Fifth Grade
- 1:30 – 1:45 pm – Second Grade & Mr. Korellis' Class
- 1:50 – 2:05 pm – Fourth Grade

After the parade, students will return to their classes to finish out the school day. **Dismissal is at 2:35 from the regular dismissal doors.**

The Main Office will have a list of volunteers for the event – all volunteers must sign in upon arrival. Because all festivities will be taking place outside, no other visitors will be permitted in the school building that day.

Students who are not participating in Trunk-or-Treat will meet in the Auditorium and/or on the Playground for a fun activity and snacks.
