Dr. Joshi will discuss how to talk to your child about topics related to Social Justice & Diversity. While the focus will be on openly and supportively talking about race, racism, and discrimination with children, Dr. Joshi will take an intersectional approach, also addressing other social identities (class, religion, sexual orientation). Dr. Joshi will also provide an opportunity for parents to consider their own social identities, and how these identities impact the ways in which they view the world, their parenting practices, and their day-to-day experiences.

Khyati Y. Joshi is Professor of Education at Fairleigh Dickinson University. Dr. Joshi is the recipient of the 2014 FDU Distinguished Faculty Award for Research and Scholarship. She is the author and co-editor of many publications including *Teaching for Diversity and Social Justice*, 3rd edition (Routledge, 2016). In addition to working with the School District of South Orange/Maplewood for the past three years, she has been working with New Jersey Judiciary on matters related to race in America.
