Each year, Clinton Student Theatre, in association with the Clinton School PTA, produces an all-school musical revue. **The Show** is entirely run by parent/guardian volunteers who handle every aspect of the production. The goal of the show is to build a sense of community through the creative process of the arts. Students' unique talents and abilities are fostered to teach them leadership, confidence and responsibility, while having a great time with students from all grades. This is the largest student activity every year, with nearly 400 students involved.

Who Makes It Happen?

All Students (K-5) are invited to participate as a performer, or as part of the stage crew.

Most performance groups are comprised of approximately 20-25 students, grades K-5.

- > *Kindergarteners* can choose to be part of either an all-K or a multi-grade performance group.
- > *5th Graders* can perform in a special 'Transitions' group that will write & perform short transitional skits between the larger group skits.

Tell Me More!

Each skit has an assigned rehearsal day. Rehearsals are once a week beginning the last week before Winter Break and continuing until the week of the shows. Students can select their rehearsal day preference during the online registration process.

Stage crew includes stagehands, ushers and greeters, and runners.

- > 4th & 5th Graders can help with make-up or lights and sound.
- > Stage crew will participate in a series of Tech Workshops during the rehearsal period.

Each performance group, as well as every tech area, is led by parent/guardian volunteers. **There is no prior arts/theatre experience needed.**
